COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES/ PSYCHIATRIC REHABILITATION PROGRAM

Family Matters of Greater Washington (FMGW) Mental Health Clinics are comprehensive and innovative mental health clinics providing office and community-based services to children, adolescents, adults and their families. FMGW is devoted to meeting the complex mental health needs of individuals on an outpatient basis throughout the Washington, DC and Prince George’s county area. Our services assist individuals and families in reaching their maximum potential. Family Matters of Greater Washington treatment model is person centered, family-focused and strength-based. Services are offered by licensed professionals and paraprofessionals.

Program Goals

FMGW is committed to strengthening troubled families, care for at-risk children, prevent abuse and protect the vulnerable. In addition, we aim to be a preferred provider of mental health/behavioral health services in the surrounding areas that we serve, by disseminating quality care that leads to recovery, stabilization of core issues, community integration through mentoring and rehabilitative activities and prevention of utilization of higher levels of care.

Population Served

Our clinics serve persons from ages 5 years to geriatric. Our DC clinic serves persons residing in all quadrants of the city. Our Maryland clinic primarily serves persons residing in Prince Georges County.





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Service Delivery

Services can be provided on-site and off-site based on the individual needs of the client. Persons receiving community support services shall receive services at least 3 hours per week for the maximum units authorized. Person’s receiving Psychiatric Rehabilitation services shall be provided services as follows:

- At least 3 encounters for minors per month
- At least 6 encounters for adults per month
- Rehabilitation services will be intensive and time-limited, using medical necessity criteria to determine reauthorization of services

Hours of Operation

The current hours of operation for the clinics are Monday-Friday, 9am to 5pm. Evening and weekend hours are offered by appointment only to accommodate the needs of our clients.
