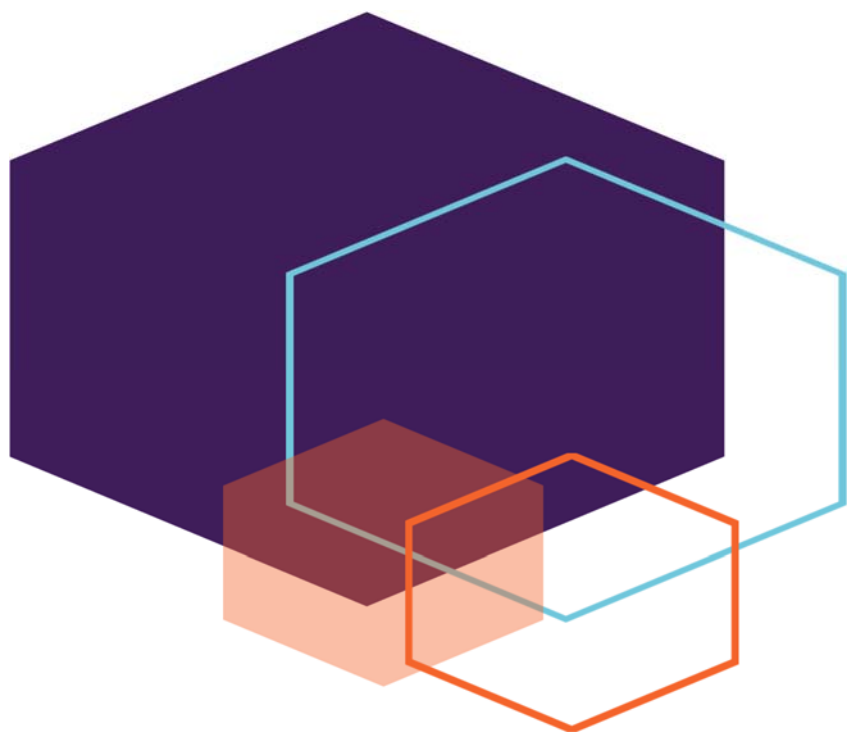


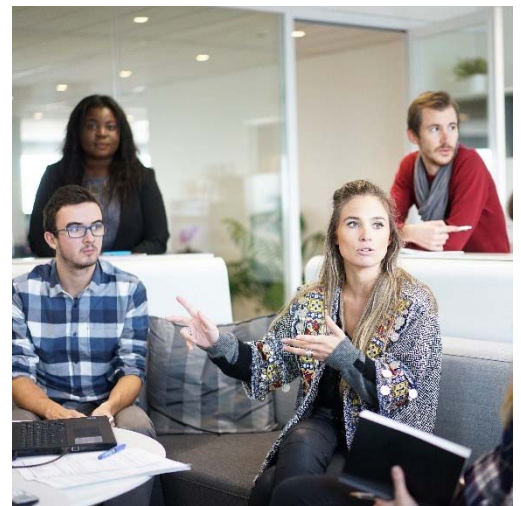


INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES
